We invite you to submit evidence on the impacts of changes in regulation and financing on the provision of care to older people in England. This call for evidence is a part of the work by the Commission on the Crisis of Care and it will inform our findings.

We particularly welcome any information (existing evidence, research and studies) you may be able to provide on **changes in regulation and funding of social care to older people since 2010** and that considers issues related to **gender and care providers and recipients from black and ethnic minority communities**.

About us:

This Commission was established by the UK Political Studies Association in 2015, and it is supported by the Universities of Warwick and Sheffield in association with the Fawcett Society and the Women's Budget Group. Our focus is on the effects of governance of care (regulation, policy and finance) on older people who receive care as well as those who provide care.

The report of the Commissioner's findings will be launched at a public event in September 2016.


